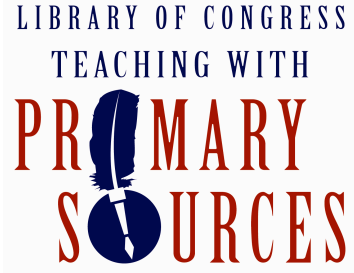


## Annotated Resource Set (ARS)

Photos of architecture from other parts of the world could be mixed in with the American photos. Students could do a Gallery Walk and identify features from all photos. Then small groups could categorize types of architecture into American and other, or more specific groupings.	Small groups could analyze gathered information into a Venn Diagram to compare and contrast features specific to American architecture to other architecture.
