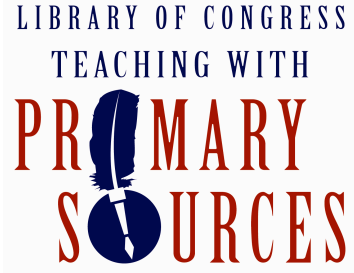







Annotated Resource Set (ARS)

Contextual Paragraph for Resource Set: After the surprise attack on Pearl Harbor December 7, 1941 by Japanese forces. President Franklin D.
